It emerged from the discussion that the University IQAC must take the following initiatives –

1. A multidisciplinary Research Project on marble slurry management choosing Kishangarh as the Universe of Research be taken up. It was suggested that the Department of Environmental Science and that of Microbiology would work jointly in consultation with R K Marble Group. The HOD, Subroto Dutta would suggest a plan by 30th April, 2026.

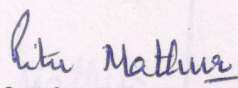

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2. That every department would establish/develop a centre for competitive examinations/Remedial Centre.
3. That e-waste Management and Bio-waste Management in accordance with scientific regulations be taken up by the Department of Environmental Science. A detailed plan be submitted by 30th April, 2026.
4. That a Swadeshi consortium be established in the University. Prof Subhash Chandra and Dr Ashish Pareek would carry out a pilot study to ensure its smooth functioning by 30th April, 2026.
5. That Divyangjan (Specially-abled) friendly toilets be constructed.
6. Campus Dialogue be organised every year to seek suggestions from the stakeholders, policymakers, bureaucrats, local politicians.
7. Alumni meet of the entire University be organised at least once in a year.
8. Placement Fair be organised at least once in a year.
9. That a University Patent Cell be established.
10. Workshops/Seminars/Conferences having policy implications be organised frequently.
11. Social Audits, Administrative and Academic Audits be conducted every year.
12. Feedback from the stakeholders (comprising parents and alumni, students) be conducted both at the initial and terminal level.
13. That government approved patent attorneys for the University be appointed.
14. University website be designed and updated in such a way so as to ensure the maximum projection of the University.
15. LMS (Learning Management System) for the University be purchased.

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16. Problem solving sessions must become an integral part of teaching to enhance analytical and critical thinking among students.
17. SWAYAM and other online digital platforms and modes of learning be promoted.
18. The Green Campus Initiative - solar energy utilization, rainwater harvesting, water management systems, biodiversity conservation be taken up in a robust way. The IQAC must prepare a plan and submit it to the competent University authority by 30th April, 2026.
19. That IQAC must prepare a phase wise implementation plan of NEP 2020
20. Complete Documentation of all institutional activities be ensured.
21. Parent - Teacher Association be founded.
