Subject: Ensuring timely regularisation of the University academic session

Respected Sir,

I wish to draw your kind attention to the persistent delay in the academic session of the University. Despite the University's best efforts, the session is unable to be regularised on time primarily because of three recurring administrative circumstances.

First, during elections and other major Government assignments, colleges and recognised educational institutions are requisitioned for official duties. This directly interrupts their academic and examination activities and, consequently, affects the University's examination schedule.

Second, during elections, as much as 70-80 per cent of the teaching and non-teaching staff of colleges and Universities may be deployed for election duties. Such large-scale deployment severely affects the normal functioning of both colleges and the University, leaving inadequate manpower for examinations, evaluation and essential academic administration.

Third, the Rajasthan Public Service Commission (RPSC) sometimes announces its examination timetable at short notice, after the University has already planned and notified its examinations. The University is then required to postpone or cancel its examinations to accommodate the RPSC schedule. This creates a cascading delay in evaluation, declaration of results and commencement of subsequent academic activities.

These disruptions, when repeated, make it extremely difficult for the University to restore the academic calendar despite its sustained efforts. The ultimate impact is borne by the students, whose academic progression, higher studies, competitive examinations and employment opportunities may consequently be affected.

In this context, I respectfully request that appropriate directions may kindly be issued to ensure:

1. Minimal requisitioning of colleges and recognised educational institutions during periods critical to the University's examination schedule.
2. Rationalisation of election deployment, particularly to avoid deployment of an excessively high proportion of University and college staff, so that essential academic and examination functions remain operational.
3. Adequate advance coordination with RPSC so that its examination schedule does not unexpectedly conflict with examinations already notified by the University.

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4. A standing coordination mechanism among the Higher Education Department, RPSC, district administration and Universities to protect the academic calendar while meeting essential Governmental requirements.
5. The University fully appreciates its responsibility to cooperate with the Government in elections and other important public assignments. At the same time, regularisation of the academic session requires that the University's examination system and essential academic manpower remain available when required. This is ultimately a matter of protecting the academic interests of thousands of students.

I therefore earnestly seek your kind intervention and appropriate directions so that the academic calendar of State Universities may be maintained with greater predictability and the recurring problem of session delay may be resolved on a sustainable basis.
