

 The journey began with assistance of Rs 1 Crore from Ministry of MSME (erstwhile SSI), Government of India, New Delhi and a similar matching grant from MDS University on April 24, 2004

 The Center is jointly promoted by Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University, Ajmer and Ministry of SSI, Government of India which is now Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises





Genesis...

- First and the only University based Entrepreneurship Development Institute (EDI) in India (देश का एक मात्र विश्वविद्यालय आधारित संस्थान)
- Rs 1 crore was earmarked for non-recurring expenditure
- Due to the lack of recurring funds to source day-to-day activities, the Center borrowed a sum of Rs 2 Lakh from the University to carry out training activities and teaching alongwith research. In due course of time this sum has been returned to the University.
- Attached with NIESBUD, Noida as the Partner Institute (Earlier it was IIE Guwahati Regional Centre, Dehradun)





(Beneficiaries at a glance till 2020)





Long Term Courses - 996





Journey so far...

- Seventeen years of existence
- Sustenance was an issue initially
- Started with a loan of Rs 2 Lac (2,00,000) from University for day-to-day operations
- Initially intake was of 36 students in MBA (E&FBM) and of 25 students in MBA (EP)
- Now the strength of students enrolled is around 100 (maximum intake 120) in long-term regular courses.





Journey so far...

- Academic & administrative issues are looked after by the Teachers of the Department Economics, Commerce and Management (Additional Responsibility)
- Faculty is outsourced (Guest Faculty, Research Scholars, visiting faculty from industry and other academic institutes)
- Achieved self-sufficiency and grown manifold

Journey so far... (EDPs)

- Organized Ten (10) Entrepreneurship Development Programmes in association with governmental agencies, which includes EDP for Doctors, Rural EDPs in Sojat, Jalore, Gagwana, EDPs for S&T students, EDP for ST students
- Organized many Entrepreneurial Awareness Camps
- As per an MOU with one of the Women College of the city Organised Six Programmes with CDC, Savitri College for the benefit and creation of women entrepreneurs (earlier)





ESDP's organized with IIE Regional Office,

Dehradun (Sponsored by Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India on reimbursement basis)

- Organised 35 Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Programme (ESDP's) sponsored by Ministry of MSME, New Delhi through partner Institute IIE Regional Office, Dehradun with nominal registration Fee of Rs 100/- . Programmes were in following trades (921 beneficiaries):

ESDP's organized with Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur (Reimbursement basis)

- Organised 21 Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Programme (ESDP's) sponsored by Ministry of Women and Child Care, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur. Programmes were specifically targeted towards females of Ajmer division namely Ajmer, Bhilwar, Nagaur and Tonk and in following trades (630 beneficiaries):
 - Beauty Parlour Activities (Beautician)
 - Food Preservation & Spice Manufacturing
 - Tailoring Course
 - of Women and Child Development, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur in Embroidery, Clay and Painting and Mehandi (150 beneficiaries)





ESDP's sponsored and organized by Center

ESDP's sponsored by Center (USP)

 Center with its own funds organised ESDP on Kantha Embroidery for Rural Youth.

All 30 participants were girls and women from rural area.

- Center with its own fund in collaboration with Choyal School of Milling Technology, Ajmer organised ESDP on Milling Science.
- This course was first of its kind in North India.

All the participants of the programme have been gainfully employed.

Bottlenecks



Bottlenecks

Center faces following bottlenecks:

- Lack of Linkages with the governmental agencies and financial institutions. Center does not get proper support from Employment Department, DIC Ajmer and other financial institutions working in the Entrepreneurship Development space in Ajmer
- Shortage of Manpower: Center is organising its activities through the University Faculty members, who have additional responsibility or charge in addition to their basic parent departments responsibilities. We are forced to use contractual/ guest staff, which results in less than 100% effectiveness.





Bottlenecks...

- Center faces following bottlenecks:
 - Inadequate follow up and tracking: Due to lack of manpower the trained candidates can not be properly followed up and tracked.
 - Infrastructure: In the changing scenario, for scaling up the activities of the Center there is a need to revamp and strengthen the infrastructure.
